History of Partnership

The House Democracy Partnership¹ (HDP) approved a legislative strengthening partnership with the Congress of Colombia in September 2006. HDP has focused its work with the Chamber of Representatives and Senate on strengthening independent research and analysis capabilities, the Chamber's budgetary oversight and drafting capacity, and legislative oversight of the executive branch. The current focus of the program with Colombia includes anti-corruption, constituent relations, and modernization of the legislature through use of information and communication technology.
