



History of Partnership

The House Democracy Partnership (HDP) approved a legislative strengthening partnership with Iraq in July 2011. The program focuses on committee operations (with a specific emphasis on public hearings and legislative oversight of the executive branch), constituent outreach, assistance to the research department, and legislative budget analysis capacity.
