



History of Partnership

The House Democracy Partnership¹ (HDP) approved a legislative strengthening partnership with the National Assembly of Kenya in 2006. Since then, HDP has worked with the Assembly to improve their budgeting and oversight capacity, library and research services, and committee operations. The Partnership encourages development on these fronts through visits to Kenya from delegations of current and former Members of Congress, Congressional staff visits to Kenya, and independent training seminars in the U.S.
