## History of Partnership

The House Democracy Partnership (HDP)<sup>1</sup> approved a legislative strengthening partnership with the Legislature of Liberia in July 2006. The partnership concentrates on the development of Liberian parliamentary staff structure, legislative library setup and operations, and legislative drafting and administration. In 2009, HDP pledged \$250,000 towards a project to develop a modern legislative library to better serve Liberian legislators and their staff.
