History of Partnership

The House Democracy Partnership (HDP) approved a legislative strengthening partnership with Mongolia in May 2006.¹ This program has focused on committee strengthening, developing, and enforcing a code of ethics, and constituent relations. HDP has organized congressional visits to Mongolia, staff training programs in North Macedonia and Poland, and training seminars for visiting members of parliament (MPs) and parliamentary staff in Washington, DC.
