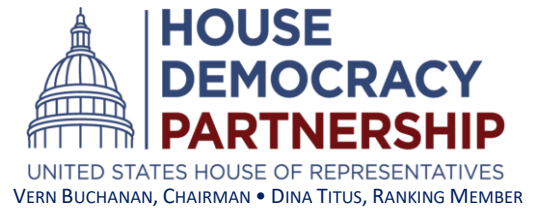

History of Partnership

The House Democracy Partnership (HDP)¹ approved a legislative strengthening partnership with the Assembly of the Republic of Macedonia² in 2006. The partnership has focused on improving the independence and effectiveness of the parliament, constituent relations, information technology, rules of procedure, staff structure, and strengthening committee operations. Additionally, HDP donated a \$50,000 computer server suite to enhance the legislature's internal information technology capacity.
